## 6. Department Updates:

LTC Salge briefed that basic and advance camps were cancelled due to COVID. In lieu of advanced camp, Cadets will attend an 8 day camp at Fort Riley in July as part of a group of 10 schools, focusing on Platoon level STX lanes, Basic Rifle Marksmanship, and land navigation.

Fall will be different due to COVID. Fall semester classes will end in-person at Thanksgiving, with on-line for the remainder of that semester. Game Ball Run and Ranger Challenge on-hold. All activities must be approved by University committee. Currently in discussions for how to hold in-person PT, leadership labs, and branch night. Expect more changes!
