





In Memoriam

Mighty Hawkeye Battalion Alum, Gary Calhoun ('68), passed away June 19. Gary was highlighted in a previous newsletter. He served as a Medevac pilot in Vietnam (may 1969-70), where he flew Medevac missions for 45th Medical Corps (Air Ambulance). Gary flew over 900 hours of combat medical evacuation combat flights. Gary was shot down, spending a night in the jungle awaiting rescue. He was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross for his actions and service. Gary is survived by is wife Judy, Iowa class of 1968.

When I interviewed Gary for the newsletter AUG 2018 article, he was very humble and told me that he didn't think that his service was so unique or amazing. That's the amazing part...paving the way for current medevac operations and risking his life to save other Soldiers in Vietnam...I'd say that's pretty inspiring Gary. You're life was an inspiration to many young Soldiers. See you on the high ground.

MHBAA) 2019-2020 Cadet Mentor 'Pearls of Wisdom' (Part 1)

Brad Cook (class of '95) note to cadets:

- In order to try to spur initial conversations, your MHBAA mentors have assembled the following 'pearls of wisdom' - things we wished we had known as cadets or new 2LTs as we embarked on our Army careers - to share with you. These are the collected bits of wisdom that we have learned (usually the hard way, oftentimes more than once) over our hundreds of years of combined Army experiences. Please skim through them to see if there's any information you might not already know and feel free to ask your mentor

DDOFFECIONAL TRAINING
PROFESSIONAL TRAINING

- Military Decision Making Process (MDMP) Steps / how to show or verbalize you used those steps (we learned it in ROTC but I don't feel like we practiced it enough)
- Reading / writing Operations Orders (OPORDs) (I think Uofl cadets got practice with this more than those of us from Coe)
- Complete a writing for Business and Industry course. A large portion of what you will do in your Army career is to attempt to communicate effectively and professionally. As you rise in rank, you will spend less time creating initial drafts and more time reviewing written products that you receive (inputs) and have to then transform into, clear, concise, and professional written products (outputs) for higher-level leaders.
- Be a sponge. Take in the advice of your Senior Officers and NCOs, and do not be afraid to ask questions. Seek mentorship from your Company Commander, 1SG, XO and PSG; between the four, you will gain a wealth of knowledge. Do not be afraid to expand your rolodex and seek mentorship outside your company.
- Know your stuff. Building your knowledge base should be an enduring task. Learn your doctrine and regulations (even AR 670-1). Do not reinvent the wheel; the Army has provided the framework for everything you will ever do; know them and, as you gain experience, you can build on them. If you are grounded in doctrine and regulations, you will very rarely be completely wrong.
- Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs). If your platoon does not have one, build one (with the help of your NCOs and guidance from your Company Commander). Encompass everything, from administrative functions to your battle drills, so that everyone is on the same page. Always look to improve your SOPs, but ensure everyone is tracking any changes.


